Malton (New)

Is a well built market town, pleasantly seated on the western banks of the river Derwent, which is here crossed by a handsome stone bridge of three arches, connecting the town with Norton; also by a wooden bridge built in 1845, leading to the Railway Station. The town stands on a gentle eminence, 21 miles N.E. of York, and S.W. of Scarborough (by rails), and 214 miles N. by W. of London. It comprises the parishes of St. Leonard and St. Michael; and their population in 1841 was 4083 inhabitants. The Parliamentary Reform and Boundary Acts of 1836 have added the suburban parishes of Norton and Old Malton to the borough, the former containing 1,644, and the latter 1,296 inhabitants in 1841, thus swelling the total population of the Borough, in that year to 6,961 inhabitants. The market is held every Saturday; and here are five annual fairs – namely, during the week before Palm Sunday on the Saturday before Whit-Sunday, the Saturday before July 15<sup>th</sup>, on October 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, and on the Saturday before Martinmas-day. Gas Works were constructed here in 1832, and here is a Savings Bank. In 1845, a neat Corn Exchange, in the Corinthian order, was erected in Yorkersgate, at the expense of Earl Fitzwilliam. Here is also a Subscription News Room and a Mechanics Institute. Petty Sessions are held every alternate Saturday, in the Town-hall, a plain building, in the Market place. A new Lock-up has recently been erected in the Market place; Richard Hall, superintendent constable. St. Michael's Church, Market place, is a large Anglo-Norman structure; St. Leonard's comprise a nave, a north aisle, chancel, and tower surmounted by a spire, which has been left unfinished, in the form of a truncated cone. Service is performed alternately at the two churches. Earl Fitzwilliam is the patron, and the Rev. Wm. Carter BA is the incumbent. The Catholic Chapel is a neat building, erected in 1840 and 1841, and is now under the pastoral care of the Rev. Thos. Middlehurst. The other places of worship are the Unitarian, Independent, Baptist, the Wesleyan and Primitive Methodists and the Friends' Meeting House.

The Church, at Norton, was rebuilt about forty five years ago, and is under the ministry of the Rev. Edmund Day, B.D. The Independents, the Wesleyans, and Primitive Methodists have each chapels in the village of Norton; and, at the foot of the bridge, was the Hospital of St. Nicholas, founded in the Reign of Henry II, by Roger de Flamvill, and placed under the control of the Canons of Malton.

OLD MALTON is a small village, about a mile North of the Market place. A Priory for Gilbertine Monks was founded here, in 1150, by Eustace Fitz-John, who endowed it with many lands and churches, as did also the Flamvill, and other families. The site was granted by Henry VIII, to Archbishop Holgate, who founded here a Free Grammar School, in 1547, and endowed it with lands and tenements, then worth £20 a-year, and which had previously belonged to the Priory. The Church, dedicated to the Blessed Virgin, is under the pastoral care of the Rev. John Walker. It is only a small portion of the nave of the Priory Church, the Choir having been taken down in 1734. The east front is of late Norman, with some specimens of the lancet style. The west door has a handsome receding arch, composed of various mouldings, springing from an impost composed of the capitals of seven columns, attached to each jamb. The mouldings are a beautiful specimen of the lozenge, highly enriched; also the chevron and the diagonal flower, all executed in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The great Earl Siward, who defeated Macbeth, was one of the lords of Malton; and, after the Norman Conquest, the baronial family of Vesci built here a castle and a priory, for Gilbertine Canons, of both of which there are remains to this day. On the site of the castle, Ralph Lord Eure built a noble castellated mansion, in the 16<sup>th</sup> century, but his Lordship's two grand-daughters disagreeing about the property here, the mansion was pulled down, and the materials divided between them, by Henry Marwood Esq., the High Sheriff of the County of York, in 1674; the lodge and gateway, however, were left, and serve as a monument of the folly and vindictiveness of family feuds. Malton sends two members to Parliament; and has, in the list of its former representatives, the names of Edmund Burke and Henry Grattan, senators, whose learning and eloquence were the pride of their own, and the admiration of other countries. The present members are, John Walbanke Childers and John Evelyn Denison Esqs.

County Court, held at the Town Hall, and comprises 96 parishes, townships and Hamlets. Wm. Raines, Esq., Judge; Henry Jackson, Esq and Wm. Masterman, Bailiff. Actions may be brought in the County court to recover Debts of every description, not exceeding £50.

The Union Workhouse is a plain brick building, situated in Low-street, and comprises 65 parishes and townships. Mr. Samuel Walker, Clerk; and John and Mrs. Webster, Master and Matron.

Post-office at Mr. George Barnby's, Wheelgate. Letters arrive from London, York, &c., at 8am and are dispatched at 5pm, and vice versa to and from Scarborough, Pickering and Whitby.
